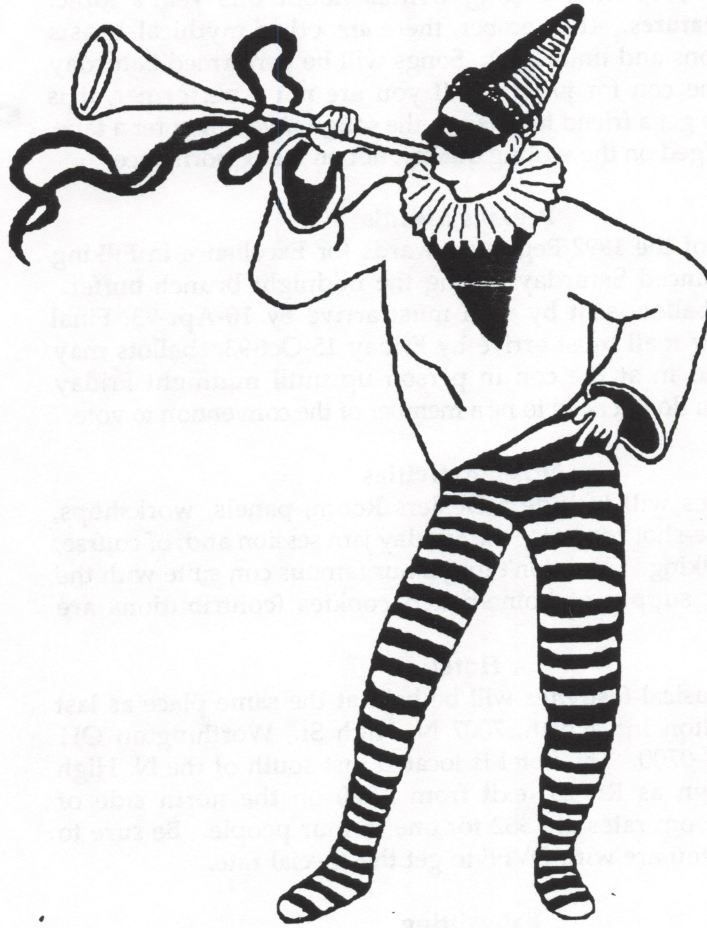

### **Song Writing Contest**

Calling all songwriters! Here is a perfect opportunity to showcase your talent. Just enter a song written about this year's topic: **Mythical Creatures**. (Remember, there *are* other mythical beasts besides dragons and unicorns.) Songs will be performed Saturday evening at the con for judging. If you are not a performer, it is permissible to get a friend to perform the song for you or enter a tape. Songs are judged on the writing quality, not on the performance.

### **Pegasus Awards**

The winners of the 1992 Pegasus Awards for Excellence in Filking will be announced Saturday during the midnight brunch buffet. Nominating ballots sent by mail must arrive by 10-Apr-93. Final ballots sent by mail must arrive by Friday 15-Oct-93, ballots may also be turned in at the con in person up until midnight Friday 22-Oct-93. You do not need to be a member of the convention to vote.

### **Other Activities**

Other activities will include a Dealers Room, panels, workshops, formal and one-shot concerts, the Sunday jam session and, of course, lots of open filking. And don't forget our famous con suite with the never ending supply of home-baked cookies (contributions are welcome).

### **Hotel**

This year's musical festivities will be held at the same place as last year: the Hilton Inn North, 7007 N. High St., Worthington OH 43085, 614-436-0700. The hotel is located just south of the N. High St. (also known as Rt. 23) exit from I-270 on the north side of Columbus. Room rates are \$62 for one to four people. Be sure to mention that you are with OVFF to get the special rate.

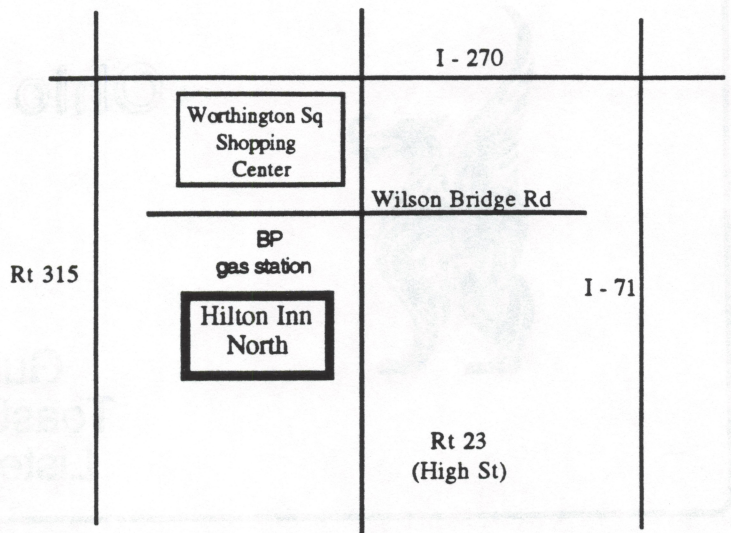
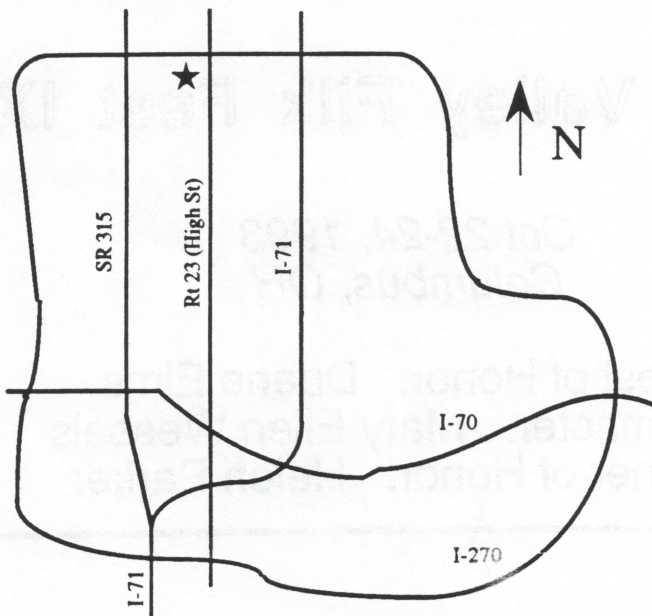
### **Babysitting**

Free babysitting is included with a child's membership. ### **Memberships**

Adult memberships are \$18 until 30-Apr-93, \$20 until 08-Oct-93, and \$25 at the door. A child's membership is \$15 until 08-Oct-93, \$20 at the door. Children under 12 who don't use babysitting and don't attend programming, and toddlers-in-tow who don't use babysitting are admitted free. Dealer tables are \$15 each (membership not included).
