Pegasus Awards

Nominating ballots for the 1996 Pegasus Awards for Excellence in Filking must arrive by 15-Apr-96. Final ballots sent by mail must arrive by Friday 18-Oct-96; final ballots may also be turned in at the con in person up until midnight Friday 25-Oct-96. You do not need to be a member of the convention to vote. The winners will be announced at the Saturday evening buffet banquet. We encourage you to copy and distribute the ballots as widely as possible.

Two Song Writing Contests

One wasn't good enough, we had to have more! So, once again, we'll have two contests. The first is for original lyrics set to existing music: Songs You Can Sing in the Shower. The second, for original lyrics & music, is: First Contact. Songs will be presented for judging at the con. Songs are judged on the writing quality; not on the performance. It is perfectly acceptable to submit entries by tape or have a friend present the piece for you. Entries are limited to first-come availability; sign-up at the convention. You may only enter one contest.

COST: Adult memberships are \$20 until 15-Apr-96, \$22 until 15-Oct-96, and \$25 at the door. Children's memberships (kids under 12 who don't use babysitting) are \$3 until 15-Oct-95, and \$5 at the door. A child's membership with babystting is \$20. Toddlers-in-tow who don't use babysitting are admitted free. *Note:* There is an "in-tow" qualifier. If your child is found wandering, you will be expected to pay the at-the-door rate for a babysitting membership. Dealer tables are \$15 each (membership & batteries not included).

BABYSITTING: Babysitting will be available Friday evening, Saturday afternoon & evening. Snacks and a limited selection of toys and games will be available. Please preregister your children to reserve space & ensure adequate bodies for supervision. If you can't preregister, please call us or drop us a line & let us know the number & ages of the children you may be bringing. If you do not, we cannot guarantee there will be room for your child.








NOMINATING BALLOT OHIO VALLEY FILK FEST 1996 PEGASUS AWARDS For Excellence in Filking




